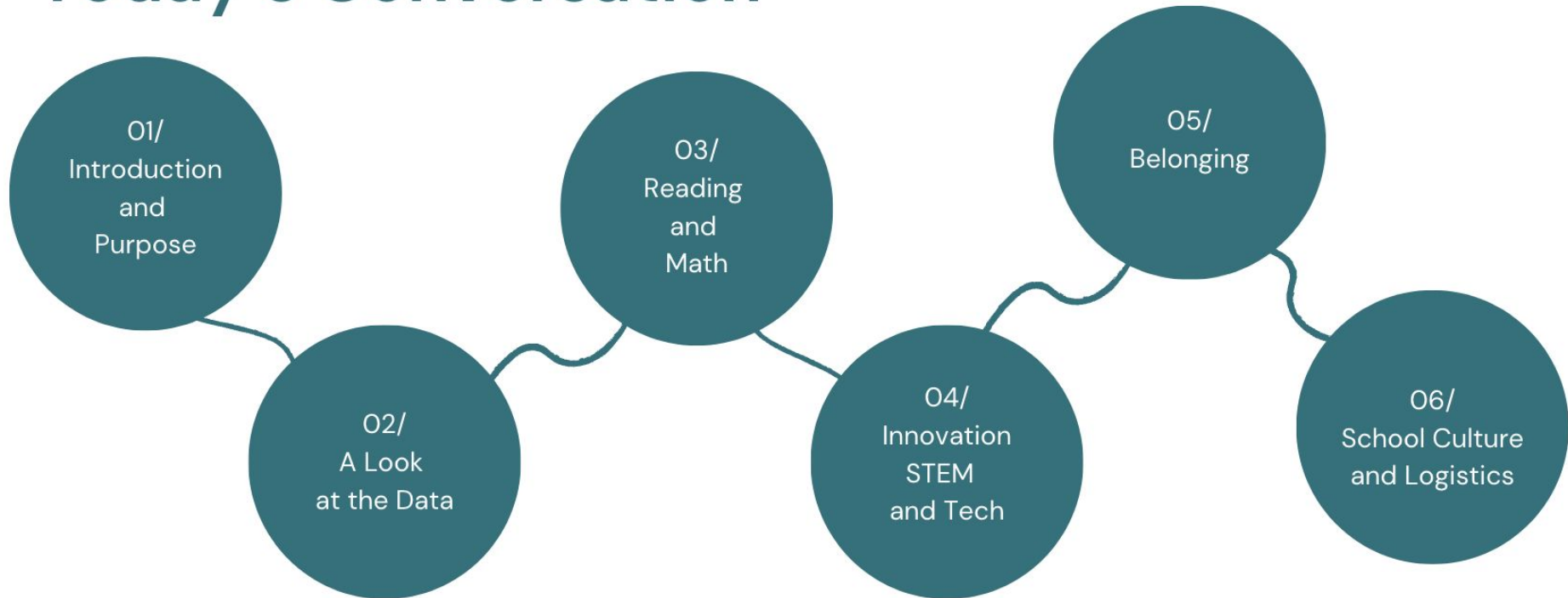

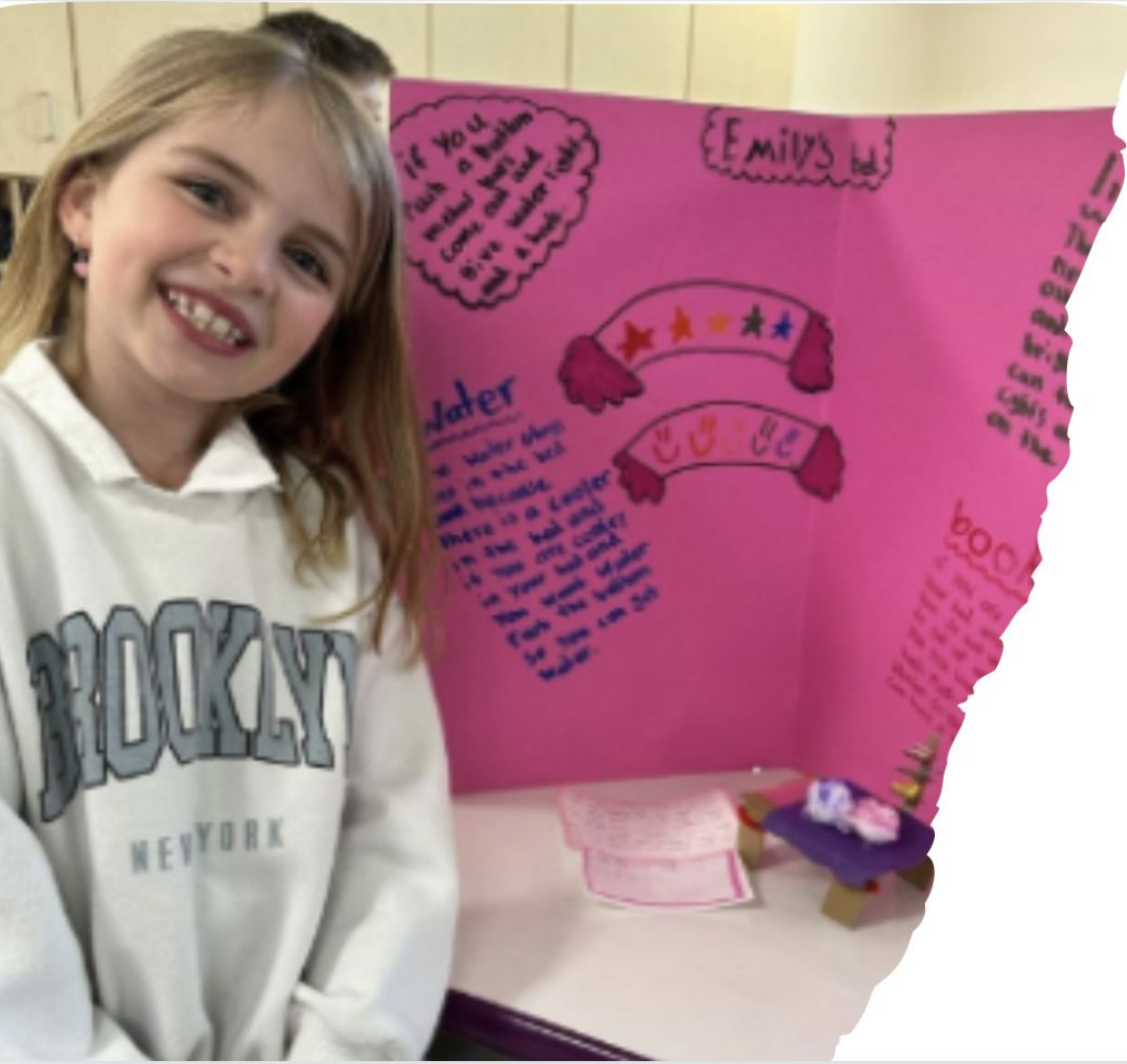

Purple = 2022-2023

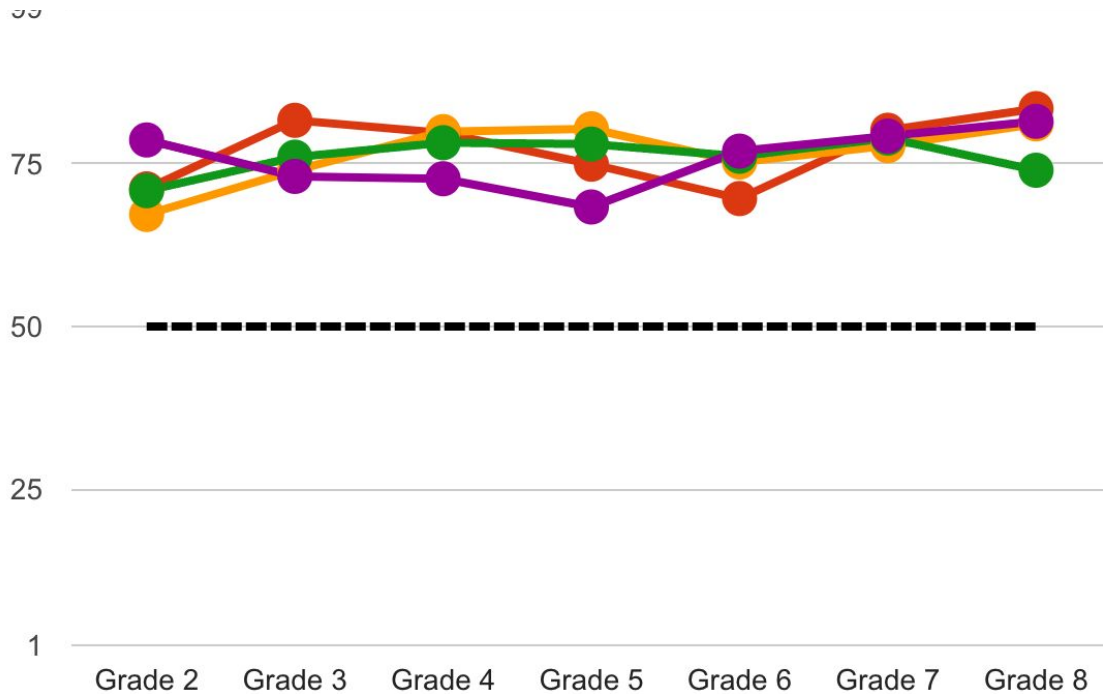
Green = 2021-2022

NP Corresponding to the Average NCE



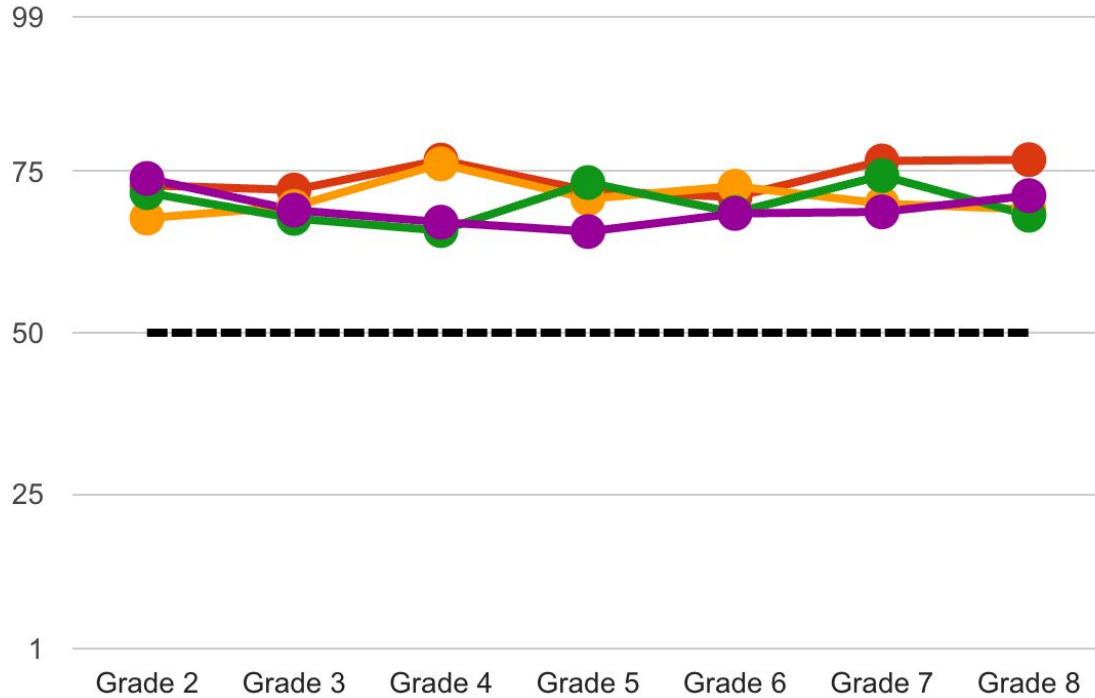

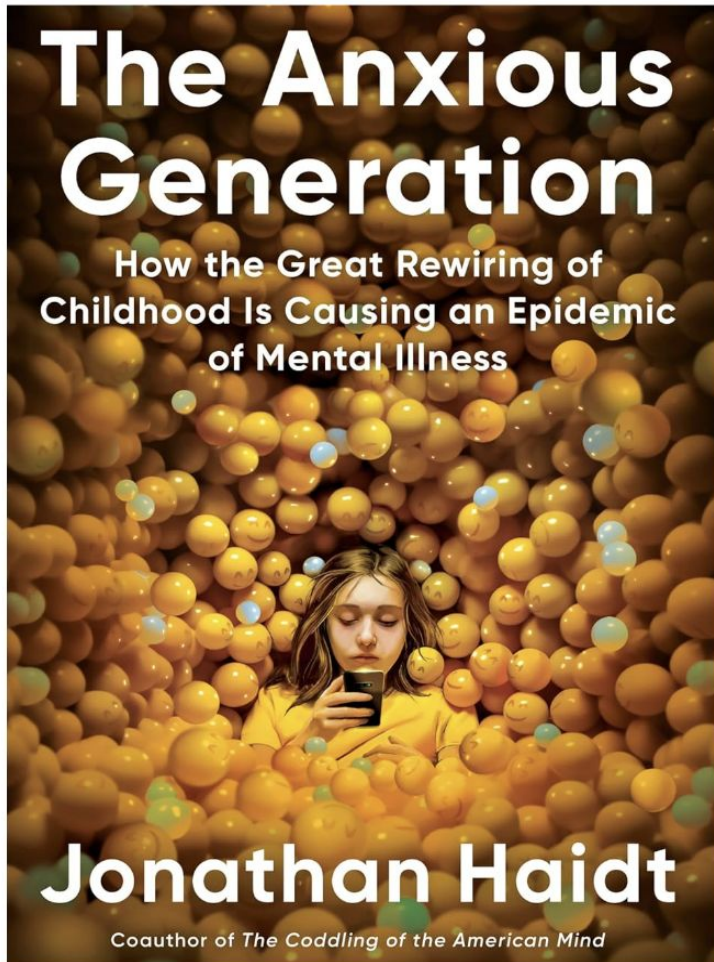

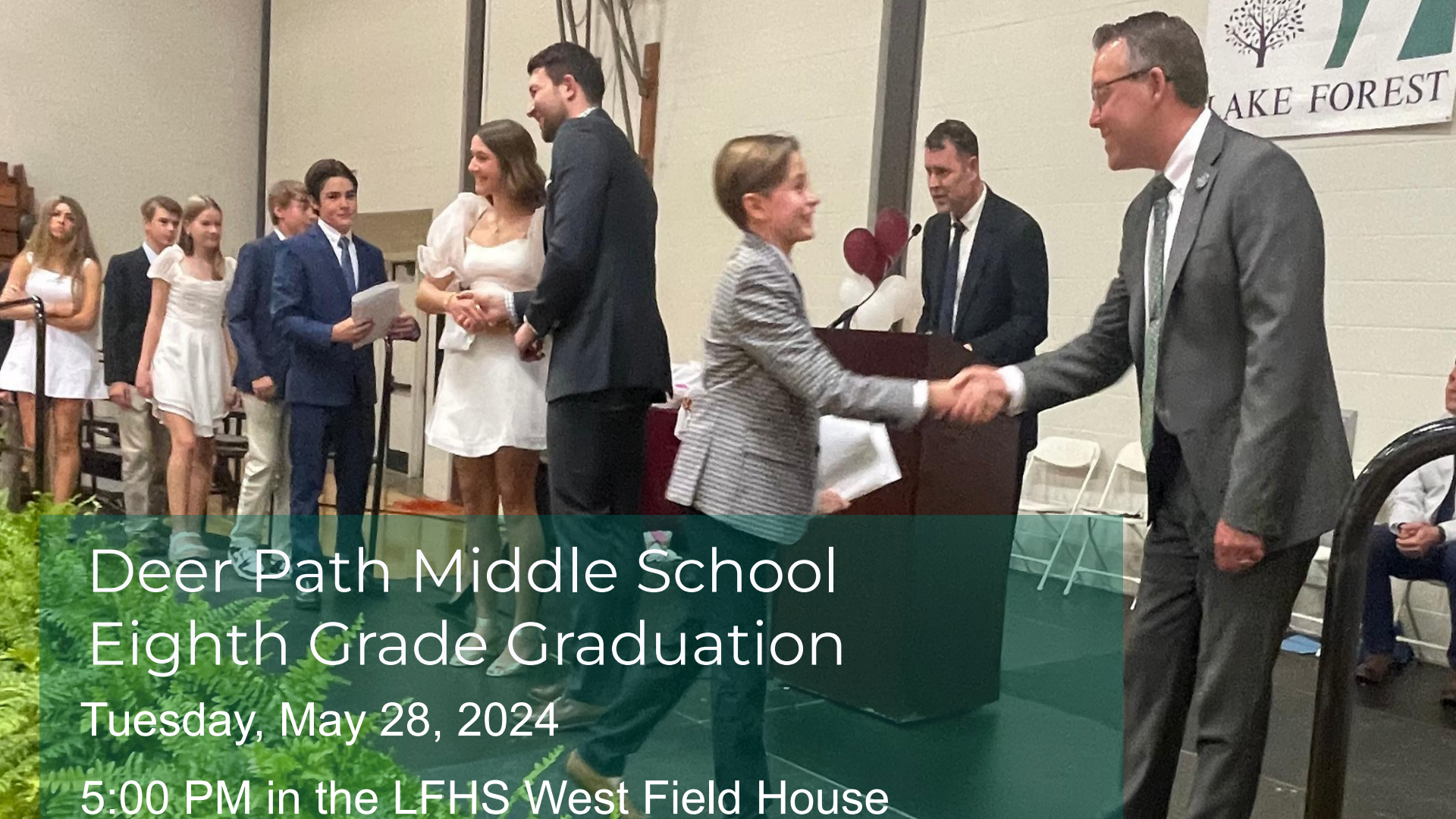
